Mrs. Princella Forney Hughes, was born to the parentage of the late Arthur Forney and Dessie Thompson Forney, October 13, 1928. She was one of twelve children born to this union.

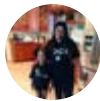

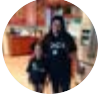
