Services for Sam V. Adams, 75, of Huntington will be held Saturday, November 24, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. in the Huntington First Baptist Church, 702 N. Main St., Huntington, Tx. Burial will follow in the Davis Memorial Gardens. Elder Sam Vinson Adams, was born to the parentage of William B. and Clara Adams on June 27, 1943 in Bassfield, Mississippi.

He received his formal education from the Bassfield, Mississippi Independent School District. After graduation, Sam entered the United States Air Force where he served from 1962 to 1964.

He was happily married to Mary Ann Bagley on May 21, 1982 in Lufkin, Texas. The marriage lasted until his demise. Sam had been employed by Lufkin Industries for over thirty years.
