**S**ervices for Jack Benny Ligon Jr., 72, of Diboll will be held Saturday, May 18, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. in the Shiloh Baptist Church, 100 Pine St., Diboll, TX. Burial will follow in the Forest Haven Cemetery in Diboll. Mr. Ligon was born May 12, 1946 in Diboll and died May 8, 2019 in Diboll.

Jack B. Ligon served in the United States Army from 1968 — 1972. His specialty title while serving in the U.S Army was a 36-C20 Lineman. He also served in the Vietnam War. Continuing title consist of Corporal E-4 rank, as well as a military paratrooper, functioning as part of an airborne force.

On May 12, 1946 In Texas Jack and Edna Kirksey-Ligon were blessed with a handsome baby boy whom they named Jack Benny Ligon. He was the fourth child born to this matrimony. He had a loving home.
