He served in the United States Army in World War II as a cook. Following his service in the Army, he worked as a Lone Shore-man in Galveston, Texas. Later in life he became a logger and a rancher, fulfilling these duties until his health began to decline and believe it or not, he was into his mid nineties at that time.

On May 29, 2019 Mr. Will Mask departed this life in Lufkin, Texas.
