Bennie was born on September 31, 1927, in Lufkin, Texas in the Keltys Community to the parentage of Oscar Moye Sr. and Clyde Moten - Moye.

Bennie will be viewed on Friday, February 7, 2020, in the Colonial Mortuary Chapel.

Bennie had been married to the late Lucielle Johnson-Moye on July 2, 1952. Bennie was a member of Mt. Calvary Baptist Church where he served as a Deacon. He was active in many organizations including the Lufkin Chamber of Commerce, Kiwanas Club-Seniors, North Lufkin Neighborhood Association, One of the founders of Crime Stoppers, Lufkin Police

Academy participant, Taxi Cab Committee, and Steering Committee. He served in the United States Army from December 2, 1952, retiring on January 6, 1979, as an MSG (Retired). He had been employed by the City of Lufkin, United Postal Service, and Temple-Inland, Diboll after his retirement.
