Graveside services for Della Malone, 72, of Lufkin will be held Saturday, February 27, 2021, at 1:00 P.M. in the Davis Memorial Garden.

Della Malone was born on October 11, 1948, to the union of Alma Hale and Ferguson Robinson in Nacogdoches, Texas. She graduated from E.J. Campbell High School in 1967 in Nacogdoches, Texas.

She began her nursing career working as a Registered Nurse at Woodland Heights Medical Center in 1980. Della served as a nurse there for 41 years where she performed various roles in the nursing department but primarily served as a nursing leader.
