Funeral services for Mattie Lynch, 85, of Lufkin will be held at 2 p.m., Sunday, May 16, 2021, in the Colonial Mortuary Chapel. Burial will follow in Cedar Grove Cemetery. Mrs. Lynch was born on February 2, 1936, in Lufkin, and died on Tuesday, May 11, 2021, in Lufkin.

Mattie Ola Holmes-Lynch was born on February 2, 1936, in Minden, Louisiana to the parentage of the late James and Ethel Holmes.

She received her formal education from the Minden School District and Grambling University, where she met her husband "the love of her life," Norman Lynch.
