Saturday morning visitation will be held from 9 a.m. till the time of service. Mr. Byerly was born on October 3, 1967, in Houston, and died on Tuesday, January 11, 2022, in Lufkin. Adrian Byerly was born on October 3, 1967, in Houston, Texas to Leon Hall and Kathy Byerly. At a young age, he moved to Corrigan, Texas to live with Johnnie and Fronie McQueen who reared him to adulthood. As a young man, Adrian loves playing basketball as well as running track and he participated in both sports at the high school level. He graduated from Corrigan Camden High School in the Class of 1986.

After high school, Adrian spent most of his adult life in Houston, Texas. He began his work career as a Certified Medication Aide and later transitioned into the hospitality industry aiding travelers as a Hotel Concierge. Upon leaving the hotel business, he changed course and ultimately spent many years on the road delivering freight as a truck driver. His driving career ended in recent years when he began experiencing health issues that caused him to need frequent dialysis.
