Later, she found a spiritual home at New Life Church under the leadership of Rev. Earl Whitaker where she remained a faithful member until her passing. Ruby found joy in expressing her devotion through song as a member of the choir, praising the Lord with her beautiful voice. Ruby's personal life was marked by love and companionship.
