Funeral service for Aaron Garner, 74 of Lufkin is scheduled for 11a.m., Saturday, March 9, 2024, at the First Missionary Baptist Church, 410 Scarborough Street, Lufkin. Burial will follow in the Davis Memorial Garden. Mr. Garner was born on February 11, 1950, in Chireno, Nacogdoches, and died on Thursday, February 29, 2024, in Lufkin. Aaron Garner was born on February 11, 1950, in Cherino, Texas, to the late Mack and Ovelia Garner.

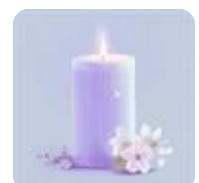
