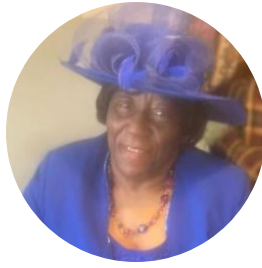

On October 14, 1939, Maxine Trotty, was born to the parentage of Irene Scott and Reverend J. W. Williams, Sr.

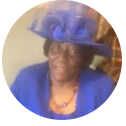

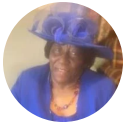

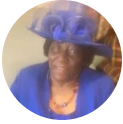
