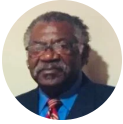
Luther Fowler, was born on November 13, 1950, in Wiergate, Texas, to the late Freddie Ben and Corine Fowler.

After retirement, he worked for five years for the City of Lufkin until his death. He also served as a member and officer of the Southeast 8th Episcopal District Annual Conference Usher Board.
