Services for Tincy Marie (Robinson) Harris, 79, will be held Saturday, September 20, 2025 at 11:00 a.m. in the Woods Memorial Temple, 230 Leech St., Lufkin, TX. Burial will follow in the Davis Memorial Garden.

Mrs. Tincy Marie Harris was born on January 10, 1946, in Lufkin, Texas, to the late JD and Velma Robinson. Raised in a devout and loving home alongside her siblings, Tincy was deeply rooted in faith from a young age. At 17, she gave her life to Christ, being saved and filled with the Holy Ghost under the leadership of the late Elder John Woods at Zion Temple COGIC. A proud graduate of Dunbar High School, Class of 1965, Tincy went on to marry the love of her life, Mr. Melvin Curtis Harris, in 1966. The couple began their life together in Houston, Texas where their first three sons were born. Later, the Harris family relocated to Lufkin, Texas, where they welcomed and raised eight more children. While supporting her husband in raising their large and loving family, Tincy worked as a cook at Lufkin High School for two years.
